AT MONKSWELL, BOLTON-LE-SANDS
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024**

The above Order, made on 18 September 2024, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the footpath from a point on Bye-Pass Road at SD 4831 6800, north through the private grounds of Monkswell directly in front of the house for 30 meters, to a new line from a point at the rear of the footway on Bye-Pass Road 35m to the north-east of the current starting point, entering the grounds of Monkswell and following the boundary of the property, crossing the stream via a new bridge, continuing 4m to meet the existing path.

The Order will amend the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Lancashire accordingly.

A copy of the Order and the Order Map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at my offices from 9am to 5pm on weekdays. Copies of the Order and Map may be bought there at the price of £1.00.

Any representations about, or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Director of Corporate Services, Lancashire County Council, PO Box 100, County Hall, Preston, PR1 0LD (REF: LSG4/SM18/888.4078/PROW) not later than 24 October 2024. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Lancashire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hollins Lane, Bay Horse from its junction with Whams Lane to its junction with Anyon Lane.

2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
