

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LENTWORTH DRIVE AND ST MARTINS ROAD,
LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY) (BUS STOP CLEARWAY)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

1. Remove a bus stop in St Martins Road, Lancaster, the easts side, from a point 4 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Eastham Street .
2. Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Lentworth Drive, Lancaster, the east side, from a point approximately 41.5 metres north of its junction with the Centreline of Hala Road for a distance of 39 metres in a northerly direction;
 - b) St Martins Road, Lancaster, the east side, from a point 9 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Eastham Street for a distance of 7.5 metres in a northerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

Lentworth Drive Bus Stop Clearway

The purpose of the proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stop to a Quality Bus Stop Clearway including the installation of a raised boarding platform. This improvement will enhance safety, comfort, and accessibility for passengers using the stop.

The proposed bus stop clearway will ensure unobstructed access for buses, allowing them to pull in and out safely and consistently. The aim of the proposal is to improve bus journey times and service reliability while also supporting safe and efficient passenger movement.

St Martin's Road 7.5m Bus Stop Clearway

The purpose of this proposal is to remove the existing bus stop and introduce a new Bus Stop Clearway in a more suitable location including the installation of a raised boarding platform enabling improved alignment and safer operation.

The proposed Bus Stop Clearway will prevent parked vehicles from obstructing kerbside boarding and alighting, enabling smoother bus movements. The aim of the proposal is to improve bus journey times and service reliability while also supporting safe and efficient passenger movement.
